Item 2: Resolution Adopting Revisions to the NCT9-1-1 Policy ADM 2.7: Requesting to Operate as an Emergency Communications Center

The recommended updates to Policy ADM 2.7 include:

- Explicit clarification that Secondary ECCs must be operated by Public Agencies and cannot be owned or operated by for-profit businesses, per state statute.
- Additional administrative updates to ensure clearer guidance for Public Agencies and alignment with current operational practices.
- Refinements to definitions, required documentation, and process steps to improve clarity and facilitate consistent implementation by staff.



Item 3: Resolution Authorizing Contracts for 9-1-1 Al NCT 94-1 Translation and Transcription Services

Why AI Language Tools Are Needed

- Growing regional population = increased linguistic diversity
- Upcoming 2026 FIFA World Cup will bring an influx of international visitors
- Current translation workflow is slow, outdated, and dependent on third-party services

How AI Improves 9-1-1 Communications

- Real-time translation & transcription to support both callers and telecommunicators
- Enhances clarity during high-stress calls, even in English
- Reduces repeated questions and cognitive load for TCs
- Improves accuracy, documentation quality, and overall response workflows

Procurement & Funding

Completed through TXShare cooperative purchasing program under RFP #2025-093



Item 3: Resolution Authorizing Contracts for 9-1-1 Al NCT 94-1 Translation and Transcription Services

Funding & Strategic Timing

- NCT9-1-1 received up to \$200,000 from the NCTCOG Regional Transportation Council to support the project in preparation for FIFA World Cup
- Funding supports one year of service covering all games and events
- Combined project budget not to exceed \$300,000 \$100,000 NCT9-1-1 funds \$200,000 RTC allocation

Recommended Vendors for Pilot Year

- GovWorx, Inc, Invictus Apps Inc. (Prepared), RapidDeploy, Inc.
- Multi-vendor approach provides: Flexibility and redundancy, Comparative performance evaluation, and Optimized service deployment across the region



Item 4: Resolution Authorizing a Contract with CyraCom International, Inc. for Live Human Interpretation Services

- Trained interpreters can accurately understand and relay critical information when a caller does not speak English fluently.
- Core component of our services required while we pilot new translation technologies, ensuring TCs have time and support needed to become conformable with emerging tools with maintaining high-quality service.
- DIR Cooperative
- Maximum three (3) years, NTE \$200,000



September 2025 Financial Status Report-Background

- September represents twelve (12) months of fiscal year 2025.
- Budget represents approved fiscal year 2025 budget.
- Preliminary fiscal year 2025 results. Final audited statements to be presented in March 2026.



September 2025 Financial Status Report-Summary

- Revenues total \$19.7 million or 108% of the twelve (12) month budget.
- Expenses total \$12.7 million or 88% of the twelve (12) month budget.



September 2025 Financial Status Report-Revenue

- Revenues totaled \$19.7 million for the twelve (12) months or 108% of budget.
 - ➤ Wireless revenue totaled 113% of budget for the twelve (12) months totaling \$12.6 million.
 - ➤ Landline revenue totaled 87% of budget for the twelve (12) months totaling \$1.3 million
 - ➤ Interest revenue totaled 305% of target the twelve (12) months totaling \$915 thousand.
 - ❖ Interest income was conservatively projected for the FY 2025 budget. Interest rates of return remained higher than anticipated.



September 2025 Financial Status Report - Expenses

- Expenses totaled \$12.6 million for the twelve (12) months or 88% of budget.
 - > Staff costs totaled \$4.9 million for the twelve (12) months or 85% of budget.
 - ❖ Below target due to three (3) unfilled staff positions.
 - Travel below budget for the twelve (12) months.
 - Fiscal Agent support totaled \$327,000 or 78% of budget.
 - > Cost of Operations totaled \$7.3 million or 93% of budget.
 - ➤ Capital Expenditures totaled \$113,000 or 49% of budget.
 - Primarily due to capital costs paid with grant funding.



September 2025 Financial Status Report – Expenses: Proposition 8

- Total funding received \$10.4 million.
- Revenue and expenses total \$10.4 million or 100% of total funding.
- Funding accepted at June 2024 Board meeting.
- Funding was fully expended in March 2025.
- The final report to CSEC submitted in October 2025.



September 2025 Financial Status Report – NG9-1-1 Grant

- Contract to date revenue and expenses total \$8.2 million
- Grant accepted at March 2022 Board meeting.
- Grant continues until December 2026.
- Capital replacement fund balance to "back stop" expenses until reimbursed by CSEC (as authorized by Board in FY 2023 Budget).
